On Wednesday, September 29th the City of Peterborough will formally launch its first Municipal Culture Planning project. The event will begin at 6:00 p.m. at the Art Gallery of Peterborough.

The Municipal Cultural Plan (MCP) will develop a vision for Peterborough, highlighting economic development, social progress and quality of life. It will focus on culture's role in creating a livable sustainable community with a vibrant downtown and healthy neighbourhoods. Through extensive community engagement, the Plan aims to generate a shared cultural vision in Peterborough and provide a set of guiding principles and actions that ensures Peterborough reaches its greatest potential as a culturally vibrant, creative city.

For the creation of the plan, the City has chosen an award winning team with substantial experience working in cultural development across Ontario and Canada. Consultants from the integrated design firm, Dialog, are leading the process in association with Jenny Ginder of Ginder Consulting.
